Apply to be a Teacher Resident with the Health Leadership High School

## What is a Teacher Residency?

•A teacher preparation program for any graduate or undergraduate student who wants to become a teacher who is in their final year of teacher preparation.

• A paid, year long rigorous guided apprenticeship with an experienced co-teacher.\*

• A commitment to Health Leadership High School for a minimum of 3 years after residency.

\*Pending funding from the New Mexico State Legislature in 2024. A typical stipend is \$35,000 per year (taxable income).

•Secondary English Language Arts (7-12)

•Secondary Mathematics (7-12)
