Apply to be a Teacher Resident with the **Health Leadership High School**

What is a Teacher Residency?

- A teacher preparation program for any **graduate or undergraduate student** who wants to become a teacher who is **in their final year of teacher preparation**.
- A **paid, year long rigorous guided apprenticeship** with an experienced co-teacher.*
- A **commitment to Health Leadership High School** for a **minimum of 3 years after residency**.

*Pending funding from the New Mexico State Legislature in 2024. A typical stipend is \$35,000 per year (taxable income).

- Secondary English Language Arts (7-12)
- Secondary Mathematics (7-12)
- Secondary Science (7-12)
- Secondary Social Studies (7-12)
- Special Education (7-12)
